BULLY MG DEFINITION



Repeated, unwanted, aggressive behaviour which hurts someone on purpose, where there is a power imbalance.



Bullying can be social, physical, verbal or cyber.

- Speaking to a member of the Welfare Team
- Speaking to a Senior Leader
