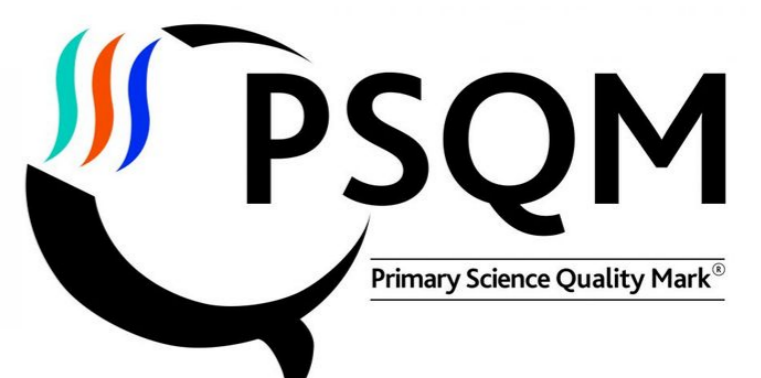

THE CURRICULUM

Teachers work hard to ensure that the national curriculum is delivered in exciting and memorable ways. Key knowledge and skills are built upon from the early years to the end of key stage 2. Children are encouraged to take an active part in their learning.

At Oakway Academy we offer a curriculum that is broad and balanced which builds on the knowledge, understanding, and skills of all children, whatever their starting points. The aim of our knowledge-based curriculum is for pupils to have the essential knowledge, skills and wide understanding to be successful, independent and motivated learners in readiness for the next stage of education. Our curriculum is structured but playful and builds on the children's knowledge and skills in all areas of learning.

Our Early Years staff sensitively support children's play through skillful interactions that extend their learning and help the children to develop new ways of thinking and interests. Our aim is for all children to be curious, passionate, resilient learners who possess a broad range of knowledge and skills ready to continue their learning and development in Key Stage One.

We recognise that the learning environment plays a key part in supporting and extending the children's development. The physical Early Years environment has open and spacious inside and outside shared areas, carefully designed to promote all areas of learning so that children can access resources independently supported by our skilled Early Years practitioners.
