All spectators must stay outside of the roped area at all times.

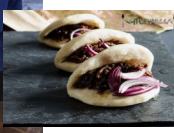
Children will be taking part in a number of activities across the allocated time to earn points for their class.

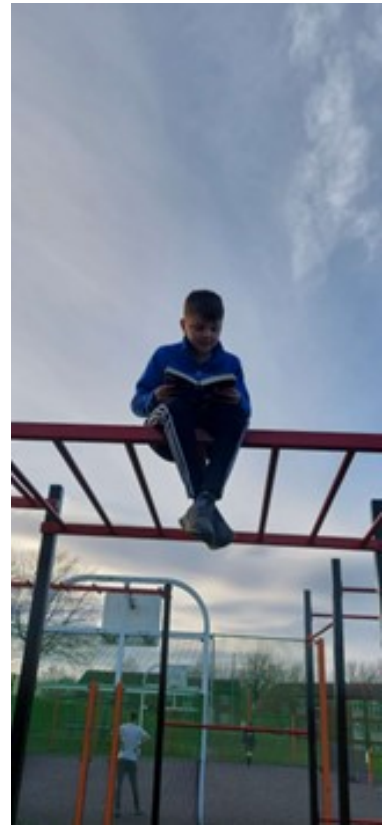


## 'Reading in unusual places' competition
