Please arrive at 10am promptly allowing plenty of time before the gates close at 10.15am. Please note that the Hemmingwell gate will NOT be open for parents.

You are welcome to take photos of your child though please use them for personal use only and please do not share on any social media platforms. The warm up for the race will start at 10.20am with the race starting at 10.30am. Please ensure that you remain within the designated spectators area, you will NOT be able to walk through onto the Oakway playing fields via the middle gate as runners will be coming through! Please ensure that your child wears their Oakway PE kit on this day and brings a water bottle, sun hat and wears sun cream if it is hot.
