

As we come to the end of Term 6 we can reflect on all of the amazing things that have happened at Oakway this academic year.

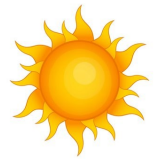

After School Club

We are pleased to inform parents that from September we will be running our own after school club to run alongside the clubs run by LM Academy who will run sports clubs from 3.30pm to 4.30pm each day. As many children need after school care but perhaps don't want to play football, or do gymnastics, we are looking to run a club where children can come and relax, unwind after a day at school and most importantly have some fun!

Where is Club & what time?

In the Lodge from 3.30pm to 5.30pm
or if you just need a top up after attending LM Academy you can book a top up from 4.30pm to 5.30pm

How much is it?

If you need your child to attend the whole session from 3.30pm—5.30pm - £6.00

A top up from after sports club from 4.30pm—5.30pm - £3.00

LM sports clubs cost £4.00 for a session

How do I book my child on?

Bookings will be made via Parentmail - more information will be sent out over the summer holidays when bookings go live!

What activities will they be doing?

The children will be taking part in different activities such as art & crafts, gardening, chill out time, playing games, the opportunity to do their homework—the children will have a say in how they want their club to be run & the activities they want to do.

Do I need to book in advance?

All bookings MUST be made at least 24 hours in advance as places are limited! In an emergency situation please ring the office to book your child's place.

Do I need to pay in advance?

All sessions must be paid for at the time of booking. If you give 24 hours notice of cancellation a session can be refunded.

How do I book LM sports clubs?

Where do I collect my child from?

The wooden doors by Year 3 where 1B & 3B get dropped off & picked up from next to the car park. There will be a doorbell for you to ring & staff will come and see you.

We ask that children aren't collected before 4.30pm if possible as the children will be outside playing & exploring! If you need to collect them earlier please come to the school office.

Will food be provided?

We ask that you send your child with a snack to have during club. Drinks will be provided.

What about breakfast club?

Breakfast club will still be run by LM Academy in the Arena. Bookings should be made via their website in the same way.

Is your child in Year 2? You may be entitled to Free School Meals from September

Just a reminder to parents of children in Year 2 that from September 2024 when your child is in Year 3, you will need to pay for your child's lunches unless you are entitled to pupil premium and receive holiday vouchers. Applications for pupil premium should be made online at https://northamptonshire-self.achieveservice.com/service/Apply_for_the_pupil_premium_NNC. Please make an application if you feel that you could be eligible otherwise please add funds to your child's School Grid account at the start of term or send your child with a packed lunch.
