Consultation on our updated Behaviour and Relationships Policy

We are writing to let you know that we are consulting with parents and carers on our updated Behaviour and Relationships Policy.

At Oakway Academy, we believe that positive behaviour is built on strong relationships, clear expectations and consistent routines. Our aim is to ensure that every child feels safe, valued and ready to learn, and that all pupils are supported to make positive choices as part of our school community.

We have reviewed our Behaviour and Relationships Policy to make sure it clearly reflects our approach to behaviour, relationships, rewards, routines, consequences and support. The updated policy sets out how we promote positive behaviour across school, how we respond when expectations are not met, and how we work with children and families to help pupils learn from mistakes and develop the skills they need to be successful.

The policy also explains our commitment to creating a calm, respectful and inclusive environment where all children can learn and thrive. We recognise that some children may need additional support with behaviour, regulation or relationships, and the policy outlines how we identify and respond to those needs while maintaining high expectations for everyone.

We would be grateful if parents and carers could take a few minutes to share their views using the form on our website.


The consultation will remain open until **Friday 17th July**. Once the consultation has closed, we will review the feedback received before finalising the policy.
